LITERACY	<p><b>Recount and Explanation</b> Year 1 and 2 will be looking at recounts and explanation texts. There will be links to our History and Geography topics which we will be looking at Christopher Columbus. We will also start by studying the story Beegu. Spelling, punctuation and grammar will be worked on within our writing topics. There will also be regular guided reading sessions.</p>	<p><b>Recount and Explanation.</b> Year 1 and 2 children will continue to look at recounts and explanation texts. Spelling, punctuation and grammar will be worked on within our writing topics. There will also be regular guided reading sessions.</p>
MATHS	<p><b>Multiplication, Division and Measurement</b> Year 1 and 2 children will continue to look at multiplication as we start to look at division. We will look at various different ways of dividing numbers. Children will also start to look at different types of measurement which include height, length and capacity. Weekly quizzes will help improve our mental arithmetic and fluency.</p>	<p><b>Geometry and Fractions</b> Both Year 1 and Year 2 will start to look at geometry, the different shapes and their properties. This will include 2D and 3D shapes. They will also start to look at fractions like <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{2}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{3}</math> and consolidate their understanding of these in shapes and numbers. Weekly quizzes will help improve our mental arithmetic and fluency.</p>
SCIENCE	<p><b>Animals- including humans</b> In this term, Class 2 will look at different types of animals (including humans). Children will start by identifying a variety of common animals. They will continue by labelling different parts of the animals including labelling the human body. They will also look at the basic needs of animals for survival. Children will also notice that animals have offspring.</p>	<p><b>Living things and their habitat</b> Over the next term Class 2 will start to explore different living things that are living and dead and things that have never been alive. Identify different habitats and how different habitats provide for different animals. We will have some cross curricular links with our history and geography topic when we look at travel around the world.</p>
OTHER SUBJECTS	<p><b>History-</b> The lives of significant individuals-history of transport. We will look at Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong. <b>Religious Education-</b>What do Christians believe God is like? <b>PE-</b>Mr Jones will be exploring a range of invasion games with the class <b>ART and Design-</b> Marvellous materials-we will be using a range of materials for our art and design work. <b>Computing-</b> Children will be exploring internet safety and other forms of Multimedia. <b>PSHCE-</b> Keeping myself safe.</p>	<p><b>Geography-</b>Children will start to look at the 7 continents and the weather associated with the different continents <b>Religious Education-</b> We shall spend time understanding the Jewish faith and how they live their lives <b>PE-</b> Swimming for 5 weeks <b>Computing-</b> Beebots, Scratch Junior and handling data <b>ART and Design-</b> Continued from Spring 1. <b>PHSCE-</b> Rights and responsibilities.</p>
