Endings that sound like 'shus' but are spelt -cious. YOU HAVE PRACTISED THESE WORDS BEFORE SO YOU WILL BE AMAZING AT THIS!

There are not many common words that are spelt like this. If the root word ends -ce then sound is usually spelt -cious. The -ce is removed and replaced with -cious. The exception to this rule is anxious, where the 'x' creates part of the sound.
