## Adding the Suffix -ed

Can you add the suffix -ed to change these verbs to past tense?

**Remember the rules**

Some verbs just add -ed.

laugh → \_\_\_\_\_

If a verb already ends in the letter 'e', remove the 'e' and add -ed.

If the verb ends in a consonant and a 'y', the 'y' becomes an 'i' before you add -ed.

If a verb ends with one vowel and one consonant, double the consonant before adding -ed.

cheer → cheered

approach → approached

interrupt → interrupted

If a verb already ends in the letter 'e', remove the 'e' and add -ed.

notice → noticed

save → saved

assemble → assembled

If the verb ends in a consonant and a 'y', the 'y' becomes an 'i' before you add -ed.

cry → cried

hurry → hurried

If a verb ends with one vowel and one consonant, double the consonant before adding -ed.

stop → stopped

beg → begged
