English

Reading and phonics are still key fundamental skills to learn and we will continue to embed these in our literacy lessons. We will be working hard to move from writing simple cvc words in our independent writing to sentence writing using phonetically plausible words within it.

In Term 5 we will start with a focus on story telling. We will look at the story of Jack and the Beanstalk and Jasper's Beanstalk.

We will also look at instruction writing and following instructions before we move onto poetry and try to create our own minibeast poems.

In term 6 we will look at a selection of fiction and non-fiction books to learn about castles and the Queen. We will write a recount about our visit to Warwick Castle.

In Phonics over the next two terms we will be consolidating and securing our phase 3 and 4 sounds with lots of reading and writing to ensure the children are secure not only in Phonics sessions but also in their own independent writing.

We will continue our 3x weekly guided reading sessions to embed our VIPERS skills and using our phonics when reading.

Mathematics

Reception

For the next two terms the children will be learning about numbers beyond 10. We will look at number patterns and ensure our understanding of number bonds to 10 is secure. The children will also look at addition and subtraction as well as odd and even numbers. We will continue to look at shapes and measurement through lessons and independent play.

<p>P.E Lessons</p> <p>We will be doing Cosmic Yoga daily after lunch for 10 minutes, children do not need to wear their P.E kits for these sessions.</p> <p>For the first three weeks we will continue to have swimming sessions on a Wednesday afternoon.</p> <p>We will then continue to have weekly P.E on Mondays. Please ensure your child is suitably dressed and has trainers on every Monday. We will learn athletic skills as well as summer ball games.</p>	<p>Gross/ Fine Motor Skills</p> <p>Reception will continue with dough disco daily to help strengthen their hand and finger muscles ready for more writing this term. We will also be encouraging them to attempt to cut up food and peel oranges/bananas without asking adults to do it for them first.</p> <p>The children in Reception will have access to the balls, hoops, and big bricks everyday outside.</p>
<p>History/ Geography</p> <p>In Term 6 we will have a big focus on The Queen as part of our understanding of changes within living memory. We will study the Queen's life and plot key dates on our time line.</p> <p>Reception will look at Castles and will study the parts of a castle and why they were built where there are.</p> <p>In Geography we will be comparing the UK to other countries to look at seasonal changes. We will use maps and compasses as well as using books to look at the different climates and landscapes.</p>	
<p>PSHE</p> <p>In Term 5 we will be looking at <i>Being my Best</i>. This includes how to not give up on things and learning about how keeping healthy and active will help my whole body.</p> <p>In Term 6 we learn about our growing bodies. This topic does include using the correct terminology for all body parts, we cover this as sensitively as possible and in the context of visiting the doctor when we are poorly.</p>	<p>PSHE EYFS</p> <p>We will be working hard this term on helping others, especially at tidy up time. We are also going to continue with supporting children in building the friendship skills they will need, as well as their understanding of rules and boundaries within play.</p>
<p>Art and Design/ Design and Technology</p> <p>In Term 5 we will be continuing our gliders for the school competition. We will also look at using clay and the different printing techniques to create our own flowers.</p> <p>Term 6 will be a special term for creating portraits. We will start by creating portraits of ourselves before we make special ones of the Queen for her Jubilee.</p> <p>We will also take part in the Arts mark special day called A Day to Create in July.</p>	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>Children in Reception will have free access to the arts and crafts box which includes a variety of paints, pastels and scissors.</p> <p>They will also have access to a variety of materials to create junk modelling objects which interest them.</p>
